The New South Wales Scholarships for Health Sector Employees are designed to provide financial support to candidates from the Australian health sector to participate in the Australian Applied Management Colloquium.

The Colloquium Scholarship Program includes a commitment from WTAA to provide financial assistance to at least 15% of Colloquium participants.

Financial Support
